Makalu Base Camp Trek is a very tough and adventurous trek in the Himalayas. Many adventure enthusiasts have named Makalu Base Camp Trek 23 Days as one of the best trekking trails that Nepal has to offer. During the trekking, you get to experience off-the-beaten trails, gorgeous scenery, dense forests, picturesque villages, stunning views of Himalayan mountains, and tranquil trail. The best thing about Makalu Base Camp Trekking is that it offers less-crowded trail, unlike other famous treks of Nepal. Even though Everest Base Camp Trek (http://Everest Base Camp Trek) is the most famous trek, Makalu Base Camp Trek is the most stimulating trek.

Makalu Base Camp Trek traverses one of the very undeveloped and isolated parts of Nepal. The trail leads to the lap of the world's fifth highest mountain, Mt. Manaslu, which is explored by very few travelers. During the trek, you pass through several villages, where you will get to see the rich culture and lifestyle of the local community. The landscape you get to behold is unbelievable.

As the trail moves through Makalu Barun National Park, you get to see a wide range of vegetation and might be a few wildlife. Likewise, Makalu Base Camp Trek 23 Days offers



stunning views of snow-capped mountains like Mt. Everest (8,848 m), Mt. Lhotse (8,516 m), Mt. Kanchenjunga (8,586 m), Mt. Makalu (8,481 m), Mt. Baruntse (7,162 m), Mt. Chamlang (7,319 m), etc.

- Day 8: Acclimatisation day.
- Day 9: Climb over the Shipton-La (4,257m) and decent to Dobato (3,865m).
- Day 10: Trek to Yangri Kharka (3,610m).
- Day 11: Trek to Langmale Kharka (4,400m).
- Day 12: Trek to Makalu Base Camp (4,800m).
- Day 13: Explore Makalu Base Camp.



- Day 14: Trek back to Yangla Kharka.
- Day 15: Trek to Dobato.
- Day 16: Trek to Khongma Danda.
- Day 17: Trek to Tashi Gaon.
- Day 18: Trek to Seduwa.
- Day 19: Trek to Num.
- Day 20: Trek to Chichira & drive to Tumlingtar.
- Day 21: Fly back to Kathmandu.
- Day 22: Leisure time in Kathmandu.
- Day 23: Fly back home.
